

## Dallas Township Park Construction Slated for Summer

The long-time awaited Dallas Township park on Southside Avenue across from New Goss Manor is slated to start the bidding process for construction this May. The park plan is currently going through Dallas Township Planning

Commission and Luzerne Conservation District approval. The park construction will begin this summer.

Unfortunately, both locations couldn't work because the grant would only permit the park construction for the Southside Avenue location.

The park project initially began in 2015 when Dallas Township was awarded a grant from DCNR (Department of Conservation and Natural Resources). The site survey after the heavy rain in 2018 made the site unstable and residents also expressed concerns of the playground structure and access for small children. The township then took the time to evaluate soil issues in 2019 and discussed moving the playground to a different location such as the school district little league field or possibly next to the administration building on Cleary Drive.

Many improvements will be completed during the design and construction including but not limited to: stormwater, parking, and ADA accessibility.

The new park will feature a walking path, sliding board, rock climb, a rubberized playground surface, and benches and a table for parents and children to sit and picnic. The parking will also be expanded. We look forward to this new addition in Dallas Township.
