Spring Clean-Up for Residents of Dallas Township will be held from Monday, May 3rd through and including Saturday, May 8th, 2021.

Residents are asked to bring items they wish to dispose of to the rear of the Police Station located at 2919 SR 309 Highway, Dallas, PA from 8:00am until 6:00pm Monday through Friday, and from 8:00am until 2:00pm on Saturday. COVID-19 restrictions will be followed which include masks to be worn. Signs will be posted at the site with additional directions. The Township's Road Department will be available to assist in emptying vehicles. Proof of residency will be required at the time of drop-off. Pick-Up trucks and trailers will be charged accordingly, depending on the amount and size of the items brought.

Residents will be charged a fee for bulk items, such as carpets, overstuffed chairs, mattresses, couches, dressers, stoves, washers, dryers, water heaters, etc. Each household is permitted to bring tires to dispose of with the understanding that there will be a \$3.00 fee charged for each tire.

The following items will NOT be accepted for disposal under any circumstances: freezers, refrigerators, television sets, air conditioners, dehumidifiers or items with

tree stumps, cinder blocks, animal or human waste, shingles, sheet rock, or other building materials, leaves, grass, garbage,

freon, hazardous wastes, chemicals, brush,
